THE ORGANIZATION

Founded	November 2005, in Nederland, Texas
President & founder	Daniel Miller
What it is	The largest organization working to secure a binding vote on Texas independence

THE GOAL

Mission	To secure and protect the political, cultural and economic independence of the nation of Texas and to restore and protect a constitutional Republic and the inherent rights of the people of Texas.
What TNM seeks	A binding, up-or-down referendum in which the people of Texas vote on independence.

THE SCALE

Supporters	More than 633,000 Texans on record, across all 254 Texas counties
Public support	66% of likely Texas voters back independence (SurveyUSA, 2022)
2026 primary	More than 1.6 million Texans voted for a Texas First Pledge signer
Texas First Pledge	More than 270 officials and candidates signed - a permanent, apolitical commitment, not an endorsement

Party platform	Independence in the Texas GOP platform across the 2020, 2022, and 2024 conventions
Legislative win	HB 1056 (gold and silver as legal tender), signed June 22, 2025
Referendum legislation	The Texas Independence Referendum Act, first filed 2021 (HB 1359, Rep. Kyle Biedermann)
